## **What To Bring:**

Clothing: 1 week worth of clothing

- Seasonal clothing: winter jackets
- Exercise attire: gym, yoga, and outdoor activities
- Slippers, sandals, and sneakers

Electronics: Internet access and camera devices not permitted

No electronics permitted

Nicotine Products: State age restrictions are enforced

- Unopened cigarettes, disposable vapes
- 21+ years old to purchase

### Valuables:

- Personal ID and insurance card
- · Credit/debit card, small amounts of cash
- Families can utilize patient funding accounts

**Toiletries**: Unopened or untampered with products only

- Shampoo, conditioner, deodorant, toothbrush, etc.
- Hairbrush, blow dryer, flat iron, beard trimmer, etc.

### **Medications/Drugs**:

- Prescribed medications
- Over the counter medications and vitamins

### Other:

- FMLA paperwork
- Contact information for doctors
- List of emergency contacts (written down)
- Makeup (no loose powders)
- Books for reading (keep to a minimum)
- Menstrual products, if preferred, in unopened box

### **What To Leave Home:**

**Clothing**: Inappropriate clothing

- Low-cut shirts, spaghetti strap shirts, tank tops
- Short skirts or shorts
- Clothing that exposes garments
- Clothing that depicts drugs, alcohol, explicit language, or violence related imagery

**Electronics**: Internet access and camera devices not permitted

Phones will be locked up after admission

Nicotine products: State age restrictions are enforced

- Open or loose tobacco, black & mild's, cigars, chewing tobacco
- Non-disposable vapes or other electronic cigarettes

### Valuables:

- Jewelry
- · Large amounts of cash
- Families can utilize patient funding accounts

### Toiletries:

- Products with alcohol in first five ingredients
- Aerosol hairspray or hair dye
- Nail clippers

### Medications/Drugs:

- Alcohol
- Medical marijuana

### Other:

- Pets
- Pornographic materials
- More than 5 cosmetic items not permitted
- Pillows or blankets
- Guns, knives, brass knuckles, chains, razor blades, etc.

### Valuables:

### **Toiletries**:

- Books for reading (staff will determine if it is appropriate)
- Menstrual products, if preferred, in unopened box

## **What To Leave Home:**

**Clothing**: Inappropriate clothing

- Low-cut shirts, spaghetti strap shirts, short skirts
- Clothing that exposes garments
- Belts, scarves, excessively long laces
- Clothing that depicts drugs, alcohol, explicit language, or violence related imagery

Electronics: Internet access and camera devices not permitted

Phones will be locked up after admission

Nicotine products: State age restrictions are enforced

- Open or loose tobacco, black & mild's, cigars, chewing tobacco
- Non-disposable vapes or other electronic cigarettes

### Valuables:

- Jewelry
- Large amounts of cash
- Families can utilize patient funding accounts

### Toiletries:

- Products with alcohol in first five ingredients
- Aerosol hairspray or hair dye
- Nail clippers

### **Medications/Drugs**:

- Alcohol
- Medical Marijuana

### Other:

- Pets, pillows or blankets, CDs, playing cards or dice
- Pornographic materials, outside food or drink
- Plastic bags, drawstring bags, or backpacks
- Guns, knives, brass knuckles, chains, razor blades, sharp items, mirrors, glass items, lighters/matches, pencils with erasers, pencil sharpeners, etc.
